INTRODUCTION

The Deliverable 5.4 Organisation of second annual conference is part of the Task 5.2 Organisation of annual conference, included within Work Package 5 on communication and dissemination activities. The organisation of the annual conference also responds to Task 3.2 via the inclusion of a national roundtable to engage the discussion with national stakeholders.

The objective of the present deliverable is to give an overview of the annual RHC ETIP's event organised online in 2020 on the 15th of October. For branding purposes, the annual conference name is and will be 100% RHC Event – 100% Renewable Heating and Cooling for a Sustainable Future. The 2020 annual conference initial plan was to be organised during ISEC 2020. COVID-19 pandemic restriction measures taken by most of the EU countries forced ISEC 2020 to be postponed and our annual conference to become an online edition in 2020. The RHC ETIP Secretariat and ISEC organisers, AEE Intec, intend to continue their collaboration for the organisation of the 2021 annual conference during ISEC 2021.

This deliverable includes the program and sessions, available presentations, pictures, number and profile of participants, challenges, role of the partners of the Secretariat and next steps.

Based on the strategy defined by the Deliverable 5.1 Draft Communication Plan, the organisation of the annual conference is a powerful communication instrument at the service of the activities and purposes of the RHC-ETIP. The objective of the organisation of the annual conference is to discuss relevant technology improvements and how to increase competitiveness of the renewable heating and cooling sector.

The present deliverable is due by the end of month 36, November 2020. Even if Bioenergy Europe was to lead the conference organisation, due to internal restructuring, it was finally EUREC who took the lead with the support of the other associations, which used their networks and channels to attract relevant speakers, and to widely promote the event.

2020 FOCUS AND COLLABORATIONS

The core of the 2020 annual conference was the official launch of the publication of the second strategic document of the RHC ETIP, <u>The Strategic Research and innovation Agenda for climate-neutral Heating and Cooling in Europe</u>. Speakers and participants received in exclusive an online copy days before the event in order to let them prepare the topics and questions.

EUREC created a collaboration with the <u>Joint Programming Platform Smart Energy Systems Conference</u> <u>2020</u> based on mutual promotional support and exchange of speakers:

14 October morning: the JPP Smart Energy Systems Conference organised their Policy conference in Integrated Energy Systems for the Clean Energy Transition, with the participation of Gerhard STRYI-HIPP, Chair of the RHC ETIP's Horizontal Working Group on 100% Renewables Energy Cities.

15 October afternoon: Michael Hübner, coordinator of the Joint Programming Platform Smart Energy Systems, Co-Chair of the SET-Plan Implementation Working Group 4 on Energy Systems; and Gerdi Breembroek, Netherlands Enterprise Agency, presented the status of the Energy Transition Partnership's SRIA.

16 October morning: the JPP Smart Energy Systems Conference organised their Scoping Workshop with national program managers, and the participation of Javier Urchueguía, RHC ETIP Chair.

100% RENEWABLE HEATING AND COOLING FOR A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE IN NUMBERS

Thursday 15 October 2020 14:00 CET, the Secretariat of the European Technology and Innovation Platform on Renewable Heating and Cooling (RHC ETIP) organised the second annual online



conference, hosting 160 participants (from 31 countries, 13% from industry, 15% from SMEs, 8% from NGOs, 10% from Public affairs and 36% from research community) and 16 high-level speakers via the online platform GoToWebinar. One of the objectives of the present edition was to offer a high-level, gender-responsive panel of speakers: 7 out of 16 experts were women.

Another key objective of the 100% RHC Event 2020 edition was to create a dynamic event. With this in mind, the vent was built mainly on interviews instead of presentations.

The RHC ETIP projects database



CONCLUSIONS

The overall result of the organisation of the second annual conference is positive:

- The number of participants targeted was 150 and the event hosted 160. The online preparation of
 the event was a challenge we coped with. Despite the difficult period the participation exceeded
 expectations of the organising team.
- The synergy with the Clean Energy Transition Partnership is considered very fruitful and promising for future engagement of the RHC partners and stakeholders.

- A high-quality program supported by speakers from research, industry and national representatives. This favoured the creation of new alliances with stakeholders in order to disseminate the RHC-ETIP activities and strategic documents.

- Gender balance: one of the objectives of the 2020 edition was to present a high quality and gender responsive panel of speakers. 7 out of 16 speakers were women.
