INTRODUCTION

The Deliverable 5.7 Organization of the third annual conference is part of the Task 5.2 Organisation of annual conference, included within Work Package 5 on communication and dissemination activities. The organisation of the annual conference also responds to Task 3.2 via the inclusion of a national roundtable to engage the discussion with national stakeholders.

The objective of the present deliverable is to give an overview of the annual RHC ETIP's event organised online in 2021 on the 28^{th} of October. As in the previous editions, for branding purposes, the annual conference's name is and will be 100% RHC Event - 100% Renewable Heating and Cooling for a Sustainable Future. The 2021 annual conference followed the approach of the previous one and was from the beginning prepared to be held online due to uncertainties imposed by the COVID-19 pandemic measures taken by most of the EU countries and its evolution.

This deliverable includes the program and sessions, pictures, number and profile of participants, challenges, role of the partners of the Secretariat.

Based on the strategy defined by the Deliverable 5.1 Draft Communication Plan, the organisation of the annual conference is a powerful communication instrument at the service of the activities and purposes of the RHC-ETIP. The objective of the organisation of the annual conference is to discuss relevant technology improvements and how to increase competitiveness of the renewable heating and cooling sector.

The present deliverable is due by the end of month 36 of the project, which the end of November 2021. Bioenergy Europe led the conference organization with the assistance from EUREC and the support of the other associations, which used their networks and channels to attract relevant speakers, and to widely promote the event.

2021 FOCUS AND COLLABORATIONS

The core of the 2021 annual conference was the presentation of the publication of the third strategic document of the RHC ETIP, Strategic Report on Implementation of Research and Innovation Priorities and Deployment Trends of the Renewable Heating and Cooling Technologies. Speakers and participants received a draft of the report several days before the event to allow them to prepare the topics and questions. During the annual conference, a National Roundtable dedicated to Spain was held with several representatives of Spanish RHC industry and community. Javier Urchueguía, former RHC ETIP Chair coordinated the panel.

100% RENEWABLE HEATING AND COOLING FOR A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE IN NUMBERS


On Thursday 28 October 2021 14:00 CET, the Secretariat of the European Technology and Innovation Platform on Renewable Heating and Cooling (RHC ETIP) organised the third annual online conference, hosting 132 unique participants (from 46 countries, 21% from industry, 16% from SMEs, 5% from NGOs, 8% from Public affairs, 37% from research community and 13% from non-classified organisations) and 17 high-level speakers (i.e. including moderators) via the online platform Zoom. One of the objectives of the present edition was to offer a high-level, gender-responsive panel of speakers: 5 out of 17 experts were women.

Another key objective of the 100% RHC Event 2021 edition was to create a dynamic event. With this in mind, the event utilised interview-style panels instead of panels built around presentations.

The RHC ETIP Deployment & Implementation report presentation



The report presents an insight into the RHC RD&I community, identifying the implementation gaps between priorities and topics as they were presented in the two previous RHC strategic documents. The report also presents trends among the RHC stakeholders and their RD&I activities.

Future of RHC Technologies (panel 1)

The second session was a panel discussion moderated by Jack Corscadden, Project Officer at Euroheat & Power and DHC+Technology Platform on the future of RHC technologies. Representatives from the Horizontal Working Group 100% RE Buildings, Maria João Carvalho and Horizontal Working Group 100% RE Cities, Gerhard Stryi-Hipp accompanied by Miika Rämä, VTT- Technical Research Centre of Finland shared their views on the main developments in the sectors and on the future of RHC technologies overall.

CONCLUSIONS

The overall result of the organisation of the third annual conference is positive:

- The number of participants targeted was 150 and the event hosted 132. The online preparation of the event was a challenge the organisation team coped with. Despite the difficult period the participation was slightly lower than the goal and expectation of the organising team.
- Considering that this year the organizing team decided to not integrate the annual conference with other conference (i.e. like in 2020), but to have a standalone event, the participation was satisfying.
 This shows that future standalone events are feasible and can attract a solid number of participants.
- A high-quality program supported by speakers from research, industry and national representatives: this favoured the creation of new alliances with stakeholders in order to disseminate the RHC-ETIP activities and strategic documents.
- Dynamism and high participation: the participation of experts outside the RHC platform intrigued and encouraged a wide variety of questions from the audience, allowing this a rich interaction between speakers and public.
- Gender balance: one of the objectives of the 2021 edition was to follow the practice from the 2020 annual event and to present a high quality and gender responsive panel of speakers. 5 out of 17 speakers (incl. moderators) were women.

EUREC and BE congratulate the Secretariat partners for the support in the organisation and dissemination of the 100% RHC Event 2021.




